

The audited financial statements present fairly, in all material respects, the financial position of Keene Housing Kids Collaborative as of December 31, 2021 and 2020, and the results of its operations and its cash flows for the years then ended in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America.


Our Impact
